

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON ECONOMIC INCENTIVE GRANTS

The Wallburg Town Council will hold a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 28, 2010, at the Wallburg Fire Station located at 121 Georgetown Road Wallburg, North Carolina. The purpose of the Public Hearing is the Town's proposed intention of entering into an economic development incentive grant contract with Project Plus. The proposal to be considered is a joint partnership with Davidson County for an economic incentive contract for Project Plus grants. The Council believes the grants will stimulate the local economy, increase Wallburg's tax base and revenues, result in the creation of new and permanent jobs in Wallburg and promote the welfare of the Town and its citizens. The Council will consider all information on these grants and invites all interested persons to attend and present their views. As a result of the public hearing, substantial changes could be made in the advertised proposal reflecting objections, debate and discussion at the hearing.
